- 2. Please submit all times in short course yards. If using yard times, please indicate on the entry form. Use NT for swimmers and relay teams with no times.
- 3. Swimmers may swim no more than 2 individual events and 2 relay events or one individual event and 3 relay events for the meet.
- 4. Coaches do not need to provide names for relay teams until warm-ups.
- 5. Boys and Girls 500-yard freestyle will be limited to **5 heats** in each event. The 30 swimmers with fastest seed times will be entered in each event. They will be seeded fastest to slowest.
- 6. The "best time" column for diving entries should be left blank. Place an 'X' in the space on the form. Diving forms will be provided at the meet.
